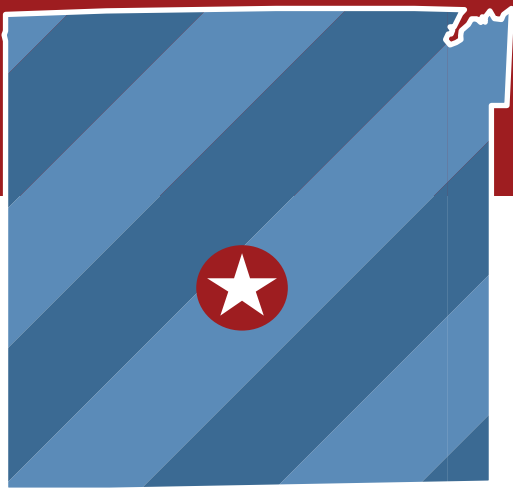


EmployIndy

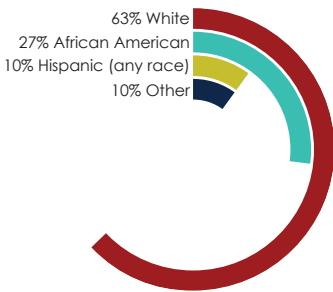

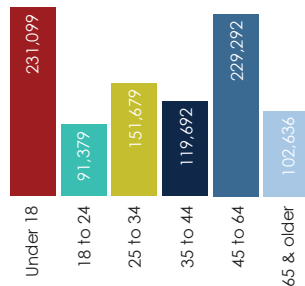

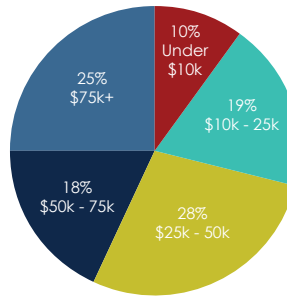
RACE & ETHNICITY



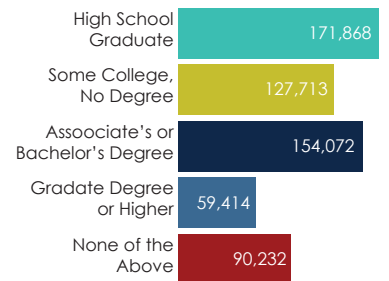
AGE
