## 6 NEW STREET MAINTENANCE CREWS

In April 2018, Mayor Joe Hogsett announced the creation of six new maintenance teams to better address potholes and road deterioration, specifically on neighborhood and residential streets.

To staff these new teams, DPW will need to hire:

- 6 Crew Leaders
- 6 Heavy Equipment Operators
- 23 Maintenance Operation Technicians
- 1 Heavy Equipment Technician

The right candidate for these new positions will have a high school diploma or equivalent; will be a resident of Marion County; and will have obtained and will maintain a valid Class "A" CDL license.

On these new teams, crew members will need to:

- Assist workers of other crews in their duties.
- Complete minor concrete work.
- Perform chuckhole patching, debris removal, sidewalk/curb patching.
- Ensure temporary traffic controls at work site.
- Trim tree limbs so they do not block signs.
- Keep daily records and log of work completed and supplies used.
- Perform related duties as assigned, and observe and follow all safety regulations.
- As applicable: Plan and lead the coordination of materials, equipment and crew members.
- As applicable: Operate and/or maintain a variety of powered construction equipment.
