


CREATING AN EFFECTIVE WORKFORCE ECOSYSTEM

VETERANS SERVICES

- ❑ Any individual who served more than 180 days on active duty (not Reserve or National Guard training)
- ❑ Any individual who served on active duty and was released because of a service connected illness or injury (does not have to meet the 180 day rule)
- ❑ Any individual who was in the National Guard or Reserves and was called to active duty during a war or in a campaign or expedition for which a campaign badge is authorized
- ❑ The spouse of a veteran killed during active duty, missing in action, detained or who is 100% disabled


