Introduction

Indianapolis Private Industry Council Inc. d/b/a EmployIndy (**"EmployIndy"**, **"us"** or **"we"**) respects your privacy and is committed to protecting it through our compliance with this policy.

This Policy describes the types of information we may collect from you or that you may provide when you visit this website or any other website or platform operated by us on which we have posted this Privacy Policy (our "**Website**") and our practices for collecting, using, maintaining, protecting, and disclosing that information.

This Policy applies to information we collect:

- On our Website.
- When you communicate with us electronically, including by email or other site-related electronic communication.
- Through mobile and desktop applications you download from this Website, which provide dedicated non-browser-based interaction between you and this Website.
- Automatically through the use of tracking technologies.

It does not apply to information collected by:

- us offline
- Any third party, including through any application or content that may link to or be accessible from or on the Website.

Please read this Policy carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your information and how we will treat it. If you do not agree with our policies and practices, your choice is not to use our Website. By accessing or using this Website, you agree to this Privacy Policy. This Policy may change from time to time (see Changes to Our Privacy Policy). Your continued use of this Website after we make changes is deemed to be acceptance of those changes, so please check the Policy periodically for updates.

Children Under the Age of 13

Our Website is not intended for children under 13 years of age. We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 13. If you are under 13, do not use or provide any information on this Website or through any of its features, register on the Website, make any purchases through the Website or provide any information about yourself to us, including your name, address, telephone number, email address, or any screen name or user name you may use. If we learn we have collected or received personal information from a child under 13 without verification of parental consent, we will delete that information. Information We Collect About You and How We Collect It

We collect several types of information from and about users of our Website, including information:

- By which you may be personally identified, such as name, postal address, e-mail address, telephone number, employer, date of birth, social security number, or any other identifier by which you may be contacted online or offline ("personal information");
- That is about you but individually does not identify you; and/or
- About your internet connection, the equipment you use to access our Website, and usage details.

We collect this information:

- Directly from you when you provide it to us.
- Automatically as you navigate through the site. Information collected automatically
 may include usage details, IP addresses, and information collected through cookies
 and other tracking technologies.
- From third parties, for example, our organizational partners.

If we combine or connect non-personal or demographic information, or information collected via automatic data collection technologies with personal information so that it directly or indirectly identifies an individual, we treat the combined information as personal information.

Information You Provide to Us

The information we collect on or through our Website may include:

- Information that you provide by filling in forms on our Website. This includes
 information provided at the time of registering for an account, subscribing to our
 newsletter, submitting a job or scholarship application, or requesting further services.
 We may also ask you for information when you report a problem with our Website.
- Records and copies of your communications (including email addresses), if you contact us.
- Your search queries on the Website.

You also may provide information to be published or displayed (hereinafter, "posted") on public areas of the Website, or transmitted to other users of the Website or third parties (collectively, "User Contributions"). Your User Contributions are posted on and transmitted to others at your own risk. Although we limit access to certain pages/you may set certain privacy settings for such information by logging into your account profile, please be aware that no security measures are perfect or impenetrable. Additionally, we cannot control the actions of other users of the Website with whom you may choose to share your User Contributions. Therefore, we cannot and do not guarantee that your User Contributions will not be viewed by unauthorized persons.

Information We Collect Through Automatic Data Collection Technologies



As you navigate through and interact with our Website, we may use automatic data collection technologies to collect certain information about your equipment, browsing actions, and patterns, including:

- Details of your visits to our Website, including traffic data, location data, logs, and other communication data and the resources that you access and use on the Website.
- Information about your computer and internet connection, including your IP address, operating system, and browser type.

We also may use these technologies to collect information about your online activities over time and across third-party websites or other online services (behavioral tracking).

We currently do not respond to 'do not track' signals and use data as described in our Privacy Policy.

The technologies we use for this automatic data collection may include:

- Cookies (or browser cookies). A cookie is a small file placed on the hard drive of
 your computer. You may refuse to accept browser cookies by activating the
 appropriate setting on your browser. However, if you select this setting you may be
 unable to access certain parts of our Website. Unless you have adjusted your browser
 setting so that it will refuse cookies, our system will issue cookies when you direct
 your browser to our Website.
- Flash Cookies. Certain features of our Website may use local stored objects (or Flash cookies) to collect and store information about your preferences and navigation to, from, and on our Website. Flash cookies are not managed by the same browser settings as are used for browser cookies. For information about managing your privacy and security settings for Flash cookies, see Choices About How We Use and Disclose Your Information.
- Web Beacons. Pages of our the Website and our e-mails may contain small
 electronic files known as web beacons (also referred to as clear gifs, pixel tags, and
 single-pixel gifs) that permit EmployIndy, for example, to count users who have visited
 those pages or opened an email and for other related website statistics (for example,
 recording the popularity of certain website content and verifying system and server
 integrity).

Some content or applications on the Website are served by third-parties, including advertisers, ad networks and servers, content providers, and application providers. These third parties may use cookies alone or in conjunction with web beacons or other tracking technologies to collect information about you when you use our website. The information they collect may be associated with your personal information or they may collect information, including personal information, about your online activities over time and across different websites and other online services. They may use this information to provide you with interest-based (behavioral) advertising or other targeted content.

We do not control these third parties' tracking technologies or how they may be used. If you

How We Use Your Information

We use information that we collect about you or that you provide to us, including any personal information:

- To present our Website and its contents to you.
- To provide you with information or services that you request from us.
- To send you our newsletter.
- To process your job applications.
- To submit your scholarship applications.
- To manage your account and provide you with notices about your account.
- To carry out our obligations and enforce our rights arising from any contracts entered into between you and us.
- To notify you about changes to our Website or any products or services we offer or provide through it.
- To contact you about our own and third parties' products or services;
- To provide you information about jobs or other opportunities that we believe may be of interest to you.
- To fulfill any other purpose for which you provide it.
- To allow you to participate in interactive features on our Website.
- In any other way we may describe when you provide the information.
- For any other purpose with your consent.

In addition, the information we collect automatically helps us to improve our Website and to deliver a better and more personalized service, including by enabling us to:

- Estimate our audience size and usage patterns.
- Store information about your preferences, allowing us to customize our Website according to your individual interests.
- Speed up your searches.
- Recognize you when you return to our Website.

Disclosure of Your Information

We may disclose aggregated information about our users, and information that does not identify any individual, without restriction.

We may disclose personal information that we collect or you provide as described in this Privacy Policy:

- To our subsidiaries, affiliates, associated agencies, and organizational partners.
- To contractors, service providers, and other third parties we use to support our



- organization and who are bound by obligations to keep personal information confidential and use it only for the purposes for which we disclose it to them.
- To a buyer or other successor in the event of a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of EmployIndy's assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding, in which personal information held by EmployIndy about our Website users is among the assets transferred.
- To third parties to market their products or services to you if you have not opted out of these disclosures.
- To fulfill the purpose for which you provide it.
- For any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information.
- With your consent.

We may also disclose your personal information:

- To comply with any court order, law, or legal process, including to respond to any government or regulatory request.
- To enforce or apply our Terms & Conditions and other agreements, including for billing and collection purposes.
- If we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property, or safety of EmployIndy, our customers, or others.

Choices About How We Use and Disclose Your Information

We strive to provide you with choices regarding the personal information you provide to us. We have created mechanisms to provide you with the following control over your information:

- Tracking Technologies. You can set your browser to refuse all or some browser
 cookies, or to alert you when cookies are being sent. To learn how you can manage
 your Flash cookie settings, visit the Flash player settings page on Adobe's website. If
 you disable or refuse cookies, please note that some parts of this site may then be
 inaccessible or not function properly.
- **Disclosure of Your Information for Third-Party Advertising.** If you do not want us to share your personal information with unaffiliated or non-agent third parties for promotional purposes, you can opt-out by checking the relevant box located on the form on which we collect your data (the order form/registration form). You can also always opt-out by sending us an email with your request to contact@employindy.org.
- Promotional Offers from EmployIndy. If you do not wish to have your email
 address/contact information used by EmployIndy to promote our own or third parties'
 products or services, you can opt-out by checking the relevant box located on the
 form on which we collect your data (the order form/registration form) or by sending us
 an email stating your request to contact@employindy.org. If we have sent you a
 promotional email, you may send us a return email asking to be omitted from future
 email distributions.
- **Sensitive Information**. In some instances, we may collect information that may be considered sensitive personal information such as racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, religious or philosophical believes, trade union membership, or information about a person's sex life or sexual orientation. We will only use the sensitive



information for the purposes for which you provide it. We will not use or disclose it for any other purpose unless we obtain your specific acknowledgement of such use or your consent.

We do not control third parties' collection or use of your information to serve interest-based advertising. However, these third parties may provide you with ways to choose not to have your information collected or used in this way. You can opt out of receiving targeted ads from members of the Network Advertising Initiative ("NAI") on the NAI's website or who follow the DAA Self-Regulatory Principles for Online Behavioral Advertising using their respective opt-out tools. Accessing and Correcting Your Information

You can review and change your personal information by logging into the Website and visiting your account profile page.

We may not accommodate a request to change information if we believe the change would violate any law or legal requirement or cause the information to be incorrect.

Your California Privacy Rights
